Redbank Plains State High School will receive**

\$1,520,563*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Years 7, 8 and 9 students achieving at least a C standard result in English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities and Social Science to 65%.
- Ensure a relative gain in NAPLAN results for 90% of students in Years 7 and 9.
- Increase student attendance rates to 90%.
- Reduce school suspension rates by 25%.
- Maintain a QCE attainment rate of at least 98%.
- Provide all EAL/D students with a bridging course to ensure successful integration in the mainstream curriculum.
- Provide all staff with professional development to support the implementation of the school's Pedagogical Framework and revised Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students.

Our initiatives include

- Implementation of strategies, including the Big Write and focused numeracy lessons to improve literacy and numeracy outcomes as measured by NAPLAN data in Years 7 and 9 and core subject outcomes in Years 7 to 9.
- Establishment of an EAL/D faculty to provide specialised support for EAL/D students in core subjects and transitioning to mainstream classes.
- Employment of support staff (Community Liaison Officers, Choices not Chances and Totally Employed Coordinators, Re-Engagement Coordinator and Success Coach) to ensure student engagement across the school.
- Provision of enhanced resources to ensure equitable engagement in the program of instruction.
- Whole school professional development to support the implementation of the school's Pedagogical Framework and revised Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students.

Employing Heads of Department: Literacy and Numeracy to enhance student achievement in literacy, numeracy and core subjects, with a focus on Junior Secondary	\$170 000
Employing teacher aides to support literacy and numeracy enhancement	\$330 000



Employment of teacher aides to provide EAL/D support and assist the establishment of an EAL/D faculty	\$165 000
Employing support staff to enhance student engagement and transformation to post-school pathways	\$470 000
Enhancing school resources (textbooks, resources and ICT resources) to enhance engagement and academic outcomes	\$335 563
Providing professional development to staff to improve pedagogy and behaviour management practices	\$50 000
