

VET ASSESSMENT

Types of Assessment:

- Formative;
- Summative;
- Direct (evidence observed at the time);
- Indirect (evidence reviewed later); or
- Supplementary (additional evidence to support claim of competency).
- Third Party/Observation

Questioning - direct	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Self-assessment ▪ Verbal answers ▪ Written questionnaire ▪ Interview
Review of products / samples - indirect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Examples of work produced
Portfolio- indirect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Documents ▪ Products with supporting documentation ▪ Historical evidence
Third party feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Testimonials or reports from employers / supervisors ▪ Evidence of training ▪ Interview employer, supervisor, peer ▪ Work diary or log book ▪ Work reports or documents
